Here's a to a new 'year' of sharing consciously in this sense of adventure!

The Changing Attitudes Towards Everything Journal was conceived last spring in a moment of spontaneity, in a moment of change from 'old', static dependencies to 'new' creative endeavors. CATE was and is meant to symbolize the 'secret' ingredient in the psyche which brings peace and harmony to each one in this transitional phase between the old cycle and the new cycle, or to put it more specifically, between the Aristotelian cycle and the non-Aristotelian cycle.

The old, Aristotelian cycle has been characterized by giving value to static images in the psychic consciousness (in your mind and in mine) and then watching in amazement as the images move, much like the individual frames or pictures are made to 'move' in a so-called moving picture. As we in our culture, personally and collectively, give value (unconsciously for the most part) to this 'show', we become enamored with it to the point of becoming identified with it, to the point of arguing for our points of static view, our values. In other words, we react according to our psychic self-identities, according to our personalities, our characteristics.

If the teaching of the SNO is true to the nature of Cosmos, as so beautifully and comprehensively described by that master craftsman, Vitvan, then the Old Cycle was supported by a certain energy pattern in the overall race psyche. This state of racial (and individual) growth was represented in our racial psychic consciousness, the Aristotelian race psyche. As the Power to be Conscious 'in' us emerges or gives further impetus to consciousness of Self, the pattern of energies 'supporting' the representations in the race psyche changes, and the old abstractions (images, names, classifications, generalizations, etc.) are no longer appropriate or true to the nature of the process going on. We now have the background qualities developed by this process so well developed that it is quite easy to recognize a sincere student of this teaching by his/her gunas, and chief among these is the 'spirit of sharing' - sharing whatever is needed - time, energies, joys and sorrows, intellectual delights of the gnostic studies, etc. For sharing is a form of giving and giving is the main function of Love, the binding force of your school and mine.
